## Why Rooftop Solar Now?

- Cost-effective renewable energy option for all Bay Area jurisdictions
- Step toward meeting requirements in 2019 building code
- Capture solar generation on housing in advance of Jan 1, 2020
- Familiarize developer and builder community with upcoming building code update
