

### **Energy Code Trainings**


- Free live online trainings on Energy Code Compliance

## Municipal ZNE/ZNC Technical Assistance

- Technical Assistance: No-cost engineering analysis
  to help local governments retrofit or build municipal
  buildings to be ZNE/ZNC, or to demonstrate ZNE/ZNC
  policy feasibility for municipal building portfolios.
- Municipal ZNE RFP and OPR Template Language: Request for proposal (RFP) and owner project requirements (OPR) template language for local governments to encourage developers to construct new municipal buildings to ZNE.





#### ePermit Tool

A free, user-friendly online tool that provides information and Energy Code requirements for building permit forms for three of the most common types of home projects:

- Replacing a hot water heater
- Replacing all or part of a roof
- Replacing or adding new windows




